That night there were shepherds staying in the fields nearby, guarding their flocks of sheep. Suddenly, an angel of the Lord appeared among them, and the radiance of the Lord's glory surrounded them. As Jesus and the disciples continued on their way to Jerusalem, they came to a certain village where a woman named Martha welcomed him into her home. Her sister, Mary, sat at the Lord's feet, listening to what he taught. But Martha was distracted by the big dinner she was preparing. She came to Jesus and said, "Lord, doesn't it seem unfair to you that my sister just sits here while I do all the work? Tell her to come and help me." But the Lord said to her, "My dear Martha, you are worried and upset over all these details! There is only one thing worth being concerned about. Mary has discovered it, and it will not be taken away from her." Luke 10:38-42

How can we avoid being distracted?

Recognize <u>good</u> things can become the <u>wrong</u> things when they are prioritized over the <u>one</u> thing.
The one thing is to be with  "Look! The virgin will conceive a child! She will give birth to a son, and they will call him Emmanuel, which means 'God is with us.'" Matthew 1:23
Recognize the <u>insignificance</u> of practically everything.  I once thought these things were valuable, but now I consider them <b>worthless</b> because of what Christ has done. Yes, everything else is <b>worthless</b> when compared with the infinite value of <b>knowing</b> Christ Jesus my Lord. For his sake I have <b>discarded</b> everything else, counting it all as <b>garbage</b> , so that I could gain Christ and become one with him. <i>Philippians 3:7-9</i> I desire you more than anything on earth. <i>Psalm 73:25</i>
