For Abraham is the father of all who **believe**. *Romans 4:16*

The Lord had said to Abram, "Leave your native country, your relatives, and your father's family, and go to the land that I will show you. I will make you into a **great nation**. I will bless you and make you famous, and you will be a blessing to others. I will bless those who bless you and curse those who treat you with contempt. All the families on earth will be blessed through you." *Genesis 12:1-3*

Even when there was no reason for hope, Abraham kept hoping—**believing** that he would become the father of many nations. For God had said to him, "That's how many descendants you will have!" And Abraham's **faith** did not weaken, even though, at about 100 years of age, he figured his body was as good as dead—and so was Sarah's womb. *Romans 4:18-19*

"Take your son, your only son—yes, Isaac, whom you love so much—and go to the land of Moriah. Go and **sacrifice** him as a burnt offering on one of the mountains, which I will show you." *Genesis 22:2*

Abraham trusted in God's _____.

It was by **faith** that Abraham offered Isaac as a sacrifice when God was testing him. Abraham, who had received God's promises, was ready to sacrifice his only son, Isaac, even though God had told him, "Isaac is the son through whom your descendants will be counted." Abraham **reasoned** that if Isaac died, God was able to bring him back to life again. *Hebrews 11:17-19*

He was **fully convinced** that God is able to **do** whatever he **promises**. *Romans 4:21*
