Most people allow their <u>feelings</u> to run their lives.

One day when Jacob was cooking some stew, Esau arrived home from the wilderness **exhausted** and **hungry**. Esau said to Jacob, "I'm **starved**! Give me some of that red stew!" [...] "All right," Jacob replied, "but trade me your rights as the firstborn son." "Look, I'm **dying of starvation**!" said Esau. "What good is my birthright to me now?" *Genesis 25:29-32*

Our feelings are distorted by sin.

When Adam **sinned**, **sin** entered the world. Adam's **sin** brought death, so death spread to everyone, for everyone **sinned**. *Romans* 5:12

"For from **within**, out of a person's **heart**, come evil thoughts, sexual immorality, theft, murder, adultery, greed, wickedness, deceit, lustful desires, envy, slander, pride, and foolishness. All these vile things come from **within**; they are what defile you." *Mark* 7:21-23

Jesus replied, "I tell you the truth, unless you are **born again**, you cannot see the Kingdom of God." *John 3:3*

You didn't come out right the first time.

Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, the **new creation** has come: The old has gone, the new is here! *2 Corinthians* 5:17 The sinful nature **wants** to do evil, which is just the opposite of what the Spirit **wants**. And the Spirit gives us **desires** that are the opposite of what the sinful nature **desires**. These two forces are **constantly fighting** each other, so you are not free to carry out your good intentions. *Galatians 5:17*
