Sometimes God allows disruptions to \_\_\_\_\_ your faith.

“But reach out and take away everything he has, and he will surely **curse** you to your face.” *Job 1:11*

“All right, you may **test** him,” the Lord said to Satan. “Do whatever you want with everything he possesses, but don’t harm him physically.”  
*Job 1:12*

When these celebrations ended—sometimes after several days—Job would purify his children. He would get up early in the morning and offer a burnt offering for each of them. For Job said to himself, “Perhaps my children have sinned and have cursed God in their hearts.” This was Job’s **regular practice**. *Job 1:5*

Did I keep my heart pure for nothing? Did I keep myself innocent for no reason? *Psalms 73:13*

“Why wasn’t I born **dead**? Why didn’t I **die** as I came from the womb?”  
*Job 3:11*
