*Ecclesiastes 7:20*

Then David sent messengers to get her; and when she came to the palace, he slept with her. *2 Samuel 11:4*

"You must not commit adultery." *Exodus 20:14*

So the next morning David wrote a letter to Joab and gave it to Uriah to deliver. The letter instructed Joab, "Station Uriah on the front lines where the battle is fiercest. Then pull back so that he will be killed."  
*2 Samuel 11:14-15*

But the Lord was displeased with what David had done.  
*2 Samuel 11:27*

Then Nathan said to David, "You are that man!" *2 Samuel 12:7*

What do you do when you come face to face with your sin?

Then David **confessed** to Nathan, "I have sinned against the Lord."  
*2 Samuel 12:13*

For the choir director: A psalm of David, regarding the time Nathan the prophet came to him after David had committed adultery with Bathsheba. (*Preface to Psalm 51*)

1. Request for \_\_\_\_\_.

Have **mercy** on me, O God, because of your unfailing love. *Psalm 51:1*

2. Appeal for \_\_\_\_\_.

Because of your great compassion, **blot out the stain** of my sins. **Wash me clean** from my guilt. **Purify me** from my sin. *Psalm 51:1-2*

3. \_\_\_\_\_ of sin.

For I **recognize** my rebellion; it haunts me day and night. Against you, and you alone, have I sinned; **I have done what is evil** in your sight. You will be proved right in what you say, and your judgment against me is just. *Psalm 51:3-4*

4. \_\_\_\_\_ disappears.

"Confession is agreeing with God that a particular act is a sin and thus taking sides with [God] against yourself." — Larry Richards

For I was born a sinner— yes, from the moment my mother conceived me. But you desire **honesty** from the womb, teaching me wisdom even there. *Psalm 51:5-6*

5. Desire for \_\_\_\_\_.

**Create** in me a **clean heart**, O God. Renew a loyal spirit within me. Do not banish me from your presence, and don't take your Holy Spirit from me. **Restore** to me the joy of your salvation, and make me **willing to obey** you. *Psalm 51:10-12*

The sacrifice you desire is a **broken spirit**. You will not reject a broken and **repentant heart**, O God. *Psalm 51:17*
