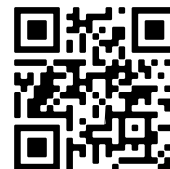
O Lord, our Lord, your **majestic** name fills the earth. Your **glory** is higher than the heavens. *Psalms 8:1*
