"Lazarus's sickness will not end in death. No, it happened for the glory of God so that the Son of God will receive glory from this." *John 11:4*

So although Jesus loved Martha, Mary, and Lazarus, he stayed where he was for the next two days. *John 11:5-6*

So he told them plainly, "Lazarus is dead. And for your sakes, I'm glad I wasn't there, for now you will **really believe**. Come, let's go see him." *John 11:14-15*

"Lord, **if only** you had been here, my brother would not have died." *John 11:21*

"Your brother will rise again." *John 11:23*

"I am the resurrection and the life. Anyone who **believes** in me will live, even after dying. Everyone who lives in me and **believes** in me will **never** ever die. Do you **believe** this, Martha?" *John 11:25-26*

"Lord, he has been dead for four days. The smell will be terrible." *John 11:39*

Many of the people who were with Mary **believed** in Jesus when they saw this happen. *John 11:45*

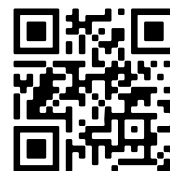
