Key point #1: Your faith can be a .

"Have mercy on us and help us, **if you can**." "What do you mean, 'If I can'?" Jesus asked. "Anything is possible if a person believes." The father instantly cried out, "I do **believe**, but help me overcome my **unbelief**!" *Mark* 9:22-24

Jonathan went to find David and encouraged him to **stay strong in his faith in God**. "Don't be afraid," Jonathan reassured him. "My father will never find you! You are **going to be the king** of Israel, and I will be next to you, as my father, Saul, is well aware." *1 Samuel 23:16-17*
