God strengthens those who fully commit to him.

"The eyes of the Lord search the whole earth in order to **strengthen** those whose hearts are **fully committed** to him." 2 Chronicles 16:9

Then Asa cried out to the Lord his God, "O Lord, no one but you can help the powerless against the mighty! Help us, O Lord our God, for we **trust** in you alone.
