Answer these questions prior to your Small Group meeting this week.

Introduction

This time of the year is a great time to take inventory. It's a great time to ask, "How's my relationship with God?" This could be the year that we become closer than ever to Him.

Discussion Questions

1. This series is called "Closer than Ever." Describe what it would look like for you, as an individual, to be closer than ever to God. What would be different about your life? What would need to change to accomplish that kind of closeness?

Read Acts 17:27. Using a scale of 1-10, how close do you feel to God right now? What are the reasons and/or factors for your rating?

2. If we are going to be closer than ever, we must make God our treasure, take pride in God, and make God look great. Of these three main points from the weekend talk, which point was the most helpful in drawing you closer to God? Why?

- 3. Read Psalm 34:1-3. In order to live closer to God than ever before we need to examine three areas of our lives. Read the following verses, and share your answers to the corresponding auestions:
- -Read Luke 6:45. What is your treasure?
- -Read Jeremiah 9:23-24. What is your soul's boast?
- -Read Philippians 1:20. Who does your life magnify?

Where do you see the most need for improvement? Why?
