Discussion Questions

1. The church is not a building - it is a group of believers living out the mission of Jesus. How does this truth impact who you are? What specific mission did Jesus leave for the church?

Danny said, "The church is the primary way that God wants to bless the world." If this mission were left in the hands of this group, what would the future of the church look like? Share some ways you intentionally carve out time in your schedule each day to help people engage with Christ and His church.

2. Small Group should be a place where you can be authentic with others, and seek help in your spiritual journey. Read Acts 2:42-47. How does your small group compare to this group of believers?

Pastor Andy Stanley said, "You are the biggest threat to yourself and others when you live your life in isolation." Even though you are "in community" (in a small group), in what areas of your life do you still tend to live in isolation? What keeps you from sharing and seeking godly help in this area of your life?

3. Read Galatians 5:13-14 and Mark 10:43-45. We are called to follow the example of Jesus as we serve one another in love. How does small group create a safe environment for the spiritual practice of serving others? What

are some ways your small group could be more intentional about serving each other?

How can your regular service to one another lead you to acts of service for others in your church family, in the community, and in the world?

4. The principle of giving financially is not just for the practical benefits (creating environments, digging wells, feeding the hungry), it's also a show of our faith - it's an exercise of our heart. In the video, A.J. said, "You can really grow spiritually by trusting God with your finances." How can contributing financially help you trust God more? Read 2 Corinthians 9:6-10.

How can giving impact your heart and relationship with God?

5. Pastor Bill Hybels said, "The local church is the hope of the world...When it is working right there's nothing else like it." What are you willing to do this week to make sure the church fulfills its mission by living in community, lending a hand to others, and contributing financially?
