It is our perspective that will allow us to live an unbroken life.

God uses adversity to reveal His glory.

- But when Jesus heard about it he said, "Lazarus's sickness will not end in death. No, it happened for the glory of God so that the Son of God will receive glory from this." - John 11:4
- Martha said to Jesus, "Lord, if only you had been here, my brother would not have died." John 11:21
- When Mary arrived and saw Jesus, she fell at his feet and said, "Lord, if only you had been here, my brother would not have died." John 11:32
- Jesus responded, "Didn't I tell you that you would see God's glory if you believe?" ... Then Jesus looked up to heaven and said, "Father, thank you for hearing me. You always hear me, but I said it out loud for the sake of all these people standing here, so that they will believe you sent me." Then Jesus shouted, "Lazarus, come out!" And the dead man came out, his hands and feet bound in graveclothes, his face wrapped in a headcloth. Jesus told them, "Unwrap him and let him go!" John 11:41-44

WEEKLY MEMORY VERSE: 1 CORINTHIANS 10:31

FOR GROUP DISCUSSION

Answer these questions prior to your Small Group meeting this week.

- 1. The main point of the "Unbroken" series has been that it is our perspective that allows us to live an unbroken life. Over the last 5 weeks which perspective has been the most helpful to you as you deal with adversity?
 - God allows adversity to bring about maturity.
 - God allows adversity to help you comfort others.
 - God allows adversity to develop reliance on Him.
 - God allows adversity to get our attention.
 - God allows adversity to reveal His glory.

What are you doing to strengthen your new perspective?

2. READ the story of Lazarus in John 11:1-40. Jesus makes it clear the purpose for Lazarus' death was to bring glory to God (vs. 4 & 40). What is "the glory of God?" How was it revealed in this situation?

READ Isaiah 43:7, 1 Corinthians 10:31, and Matthew 5:16. What is the main point in each of these passages? How does it hit you that you were given life to bring glory to God? How should this perspective affect the way we live?

- 3. READ John 11:41-45. What is God's underlying motivation for revealing His glory? How does this perspective change the way you look at the adversity in your own life?
- 4. Who do you typically have in mind when adversity hits? Who does God have in mind in your adversity? Why?

Who are the people in your life who need to believe in Jesus? How can they see the glory of God through you, specifically in how you handle adversity?
